

# Calling Contest

## Delta Waterfowl Dufferin Chapter

***Contest will be held on Saturday September 10, 2016.***

9:00am – 2pm on the baseball diamond on Dundalk Fairgrounds

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The Dufferin Delta Chapter maintains rights over the competition and images, including preliminary and final rounds of competition.
2. A caller may enter at any age, categories for junior, under 12, novice, and seasoned “over 21 years of age”.
3. Registration to take place at time of contest. Contest to take place on Saturday of fair weekend. Number of contestants may be limited due to time constraints. All contestants should check in with the score keeper to ensure they are registered 1 hour prior to start of competition.
4. Competition callers will be allowed to perform within designated area where callers will be allowed to move around and call in any direction. No other sounds of waterfowl may be made.
5. Contestants will call from a blind for 60 seconds in view of audience but concealed from judges. Contestants take position in the blind, a red light goes on for 10 seconds and contestants may warm up. When contestants start calling the red light goes off for 50 seconds, red light will come back on for 10 seconds and the contestant must finish or be penalized after 10 seconds. Cadence may be repeated if time allows.
6. Callers may use any legal pneumatic, voice or mechanical call. Electronic calls are not allowed.
7. Calls will consist of a duck “Hail, Feeder, and Locator “call.
8. Contestant will be known by number only and must wait in the waiting area until finished their round.
9. Scoring will be on a point system, by 3 judges, out of 10, low score will be eliminated, ties will be determined by call offs.
10. For any reason judges may ask the contestants to repeat calls, any conduct unbecoming a sportsman/woman shall result in disqualification. Be respectful of other callers.
11. Cost of contest will be \$5 junior and \$10 for other contestants. Prize money will be awarded by the fairground committee.
