

Dundalk Agricultural Society Demolition Derby
Official Rules and Regulations

Only one Derby car and one other vehicle belonging to each entry are allowed in the pit area.

The Derby will start at 2:30 PM sharp. All cars must be on the grounds one hour prior for inspection.

Entry fee for all cars is \$30.00.

All drivers must be nineteen years of age.

All drivers must have a number painted on the driver's and passenger doors. The driver's door and ONLY the driver's door must be painted WHITE.

Any crewmember or driver not obeying the rules will cause his/her car to be disqualified.

A heat winner must drive the same car in the feature and it must be the same driver.

There is zero tolerance for the use of intoxicating beverages or narcotics prior, during, or after the Derby. This will result in disqualification.

There will be a trophy for the best painted car, heat winners and feature winners.

There will be a hard luck heat, where no money or trophy will be awarded, but it gives a chance to go for the feature.

Welding is allowed in the following areas of the car only:

Bumpers

Doors and trunk lids

Frame welding may not exceed more than 15" from the front and rear bumper horns. Everything else on the frame must be factory.

Any welding outside the guideline will be automatic disqualification.

If this is the driver's first infraction, the track officials may decide to let the offending driver cut the welds out.

All infractions will be recorded and will be tracked for the entire Derby.

Protests: If a driver feels that another driver is cheating in one form or another, he or she must approach a track official prior, during, or within 15 minutes after the heat. He or she must also put up a \$50.00 protest fee. If the car in question is disqualified, the fee will be returned. If the car is legal, then the \$50.00 protest fee will be forfeited to the owner of the car in question. there will be NO EXCEPTIONS to the above format when submitting a protest.
